




What role did the rhythm of the voice or the drum play during delivery?

It set a healthy pace for respiration and heartbeat, and turned the parents and their child to the rhythm of the universe with which they were joined during creative moments.









Why was hospitality the most important form of foreign policy for a village?




Why did strangers refuse the first invitation?
